Scriptures mentioned:

We were buried in baptism as Christ was buried in death. Romans 6:4a NLV

As Christ was raised from the dead by the great power of God, so we will have new life also. If we have become one with Christ in His death, we will be one with Him in being raised from the dead to new life. Romans 6:4b-5 NLV

In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Romans 6:11 NIV

Summary

Dave reiterates the significance and meaning behind the 2 distinct parts of baptism, going under the water (identifying with the death and burial of Christ) and coming out of the water (identifying with the resurrection of Jesus and our new life in Christ). We also talk about the difference between our practice of water baptism (as an individual choice and profession of faith) and infant baptism.
