#### Let's Discuss...

- Who do you see Jesus to be now? Do you see Him similarly, or differently than you used to? What has caused that understanding to stay the same or change?
- Andrea makes a distinction between having grown up in a Christian home and then later having her own "encounter" with Jesus, and the shifts that this brought. Have you had a personal encounter with Jesus? How would you describe that and what effect has it had on you?
- Renaud says, "Jesus is the one that I want to build my entire life upon, and around, and towards." Do you agree with this sentiment? Why or why not? What would look different in your life if you did or didn't feel the way you currently do about this statement?
- If you have been in relationship with Jesus for some time now, describe what the process of sanctification has looked like for you so far.
