#### **EPISODE SUMMARY**

In this episode we talk about suffering, and how real it is, for Christians too, and try to reconcile this with the idea that God is sovereign.

People go through hard times and Niki talks about her own. She talks about how God never wanted these things to happen to her. In everything Niki has been through, she believes God was with her through it all and He has turned those situations around to the help of herself and people around her.

Tito talks about being careful and thoughtful when talking and praying with others. It might not be very helpful to just drop a verse or insensitive prayer on someone without considering what it may or may not mean to them, and how it could affect them given what they're going through.

We also chat about the difference between affirmations and prayer. One is more than just a helpful sentence...Prayer is a conversation with God, not focused on us, and has supernatural power to help us beyond what we could do on our own.

#### DEFINITIONS

intercede: to pray for someone else

omnipresent: being present everywhere at once

omnibenevolent: all goodness; having and giving perfect and unlimited goodness omniscient: all knowing; knowing all things

omnipotent: all powerful; having unlimited power

sovereign: having power and authority over all things

#### LET'S DISCUSS...

- Colossians 1:16 NIV says, "For in Him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through Him and for Him."
  - » How do you reconcile God being sovereign with the suffering we experience as humans?
  - » Have any of your experiences or things you've seen caused you to wrestle with God's sovereignty?
- Isaiah 55:9 NIV says, "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."
  - » Are you comfortable with trusting God even in situations that you don't understand?
- Romans 8:28 NLT says, "And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them."
  - Can you think of a situation when you went through a hard time, but now looking » back on it, you can see how God worked it out for good?
- What would you say are the differences between prayer and affirmations?
- When you think of God's omnipresence, omnipotence, omniscience, and omnibenevolence, how does it make you feel? Does this affect the way you pray?
