Episode Summary

In this episode, we discuss both the eternal implications of salvation (regarding heaven and hell) and the effect of salvation on our lives now. Although we look forward to the kingdom of heaven being established here on Earth, we pull the concept down from a faraway ideal, to something that transforms our present reality. Salvation is more than a checklist to get into heaven but should act as a turning point in the here and now, pushing us to follow in the footsteps of Christ in all we do. And very importantly, we ponder whether we'll have tattoos in heaven!?

Let's Discuss...

• What is the impact of salvation on our lives, both eternally and in the here and now?

The [appointed period of] time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent [change your inner self—your old way of thinking, regret past sins, live your life in a way that proves repentance; seek God's purpose for your life] and believe [with a deep, abiding trust] in the good news [regarding salvation]. Mark 1:14 AMP

Revelations 7 gives us a snapshot of what an eternal dwelling place with God could look like. What are your thoughts on heaven and hell? How have Scripture and culture shaped and influenced your thoughts.

After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" Revelations 7:9-10 ESV

- Does the idea of eternity play a big part in your faith and how you live life?
 - » FYI, "eschatology" is the term used to denote the area of theology concerned with death, judgment, and the final destiny of the soul and of humankind.
- In Matthew 4:17 ESV Jesus is quoted as declaring, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." How do you understand Christ's statement that the "kingdom of heaven is at hand"?
- · How does your understanding of the nature and character of God shape your conception of heaven and hell? From preachers on street corners to church services on a Sunday, discuss how the Church has historically communicated their beliefs on eternity.
