Episode Summary

In this episode, we talk about the journey of transformation that salvation takes us on. Ian even shares how his wife instantly knew he'd been changed because he'd finally offered to help around the house! We go on to chat about how salvation highlights that we cannot save ourselves, and that truth takes the pressure off us. It's not about our faithfulness, it's about God's faithfulness! And yet – He chooses to abide in us and partner with us every step of the way.

Let's Discuss...

- In Psalm 115, the psalmist warns that those who worship idols will become like what they've created. How do you see this played out in the world? On the other hand, as we worship Jesus, we are transformed into His likeness. Have you seen or experienced this as well?
- The early Church provides an example of how believers should carry each other's burdens in Acts 2:44-47 & Galatians 6:2. Do you still see this practice lived out in the Church today? What are some of the ways in which we as God's ambassadors of sacrificial love can carry one another's burdens?
- Our culture, communities and even our families can put pressure on us to be somebody who we haven't yet become. How do you reconcile the pressures you face around you; do you wrestle with comparison or the weight of expectations on you?
- The transformative work God does within us is down to a combination of the Spirit of God and our individual and collective self-discipline. How do you see the balance of the two working in you?
- Discuss Rocky's statement that God surrenders control to allow us to participate. Do you agree with this statement? How does it make you feel to know that the God of the universe invites you to do things together with Him?

What are the barriers to you extending that love that you've received from God? Are there any areas of your life you've struggled to fully surrender and entrust steadily to Him? Ask God to help you surrender every area of your life to Him, allowing Him to transform you from the inside out into His likeness, enabling you to express extravagant love towards yourself and others.
