EPISODE SUMMARY

- Activity! Read Genesis 1 and 2. Create a step-by-step story timeline of these two
 passages. Can you see any similarities and differences? What are your thoughts on
 this?
- When looking at the Bible, there are some things we may never be able to understand or prove in this lifetime. What do you think about this? How does this make you feel?
 - » For example, God created the world out of nothing... that takes a faith step to believe!

BONUS!

- The Enlightenment was a time in Europe, during the 17th and 18th century, where
 philosophy and logic led culture and people's thought processes. 'Thinkers' and
 philosophers emphasised reason and being able to prove things. This led people away
 from superstition and blind faith and eventually affected how some people valued
 abureh and the Pible.
 - » The Bible says that God's thoughts are higher and broader than our own:

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Isaiah 55:8-9 ESV

» How can we hold both an understanding of God and the supernatural while also considering science and facts?
