Key Bible verses:

We reflect on how we can look back and see God's faithfulness throughout our journeys, even when we were inconsistent in our faith. Tilly points out how the more "seasoned" you are (aka older), the more tangible moments of God's faithfulness you can look back on.

- You've come to the end of our discussion points around the theme of salvation! From the numerous questions, thoughts and videos, what new insights on salvation have you learned? What are some of the questions you still have, and what are some prayer points you'd like others to stand with you on?
